- Andreas "Andy" Bechtolsheim built the path-breaking SUN workstation while working as a doctoral student at Stanford in computer science and electrical engineering. He later became cofounder and chief system architect at Sun Microsystems.
- He also was CEO and a founder of Granite Systems, a gigabit
 Ethernet switching company, from 1995 to 1996, when it was
 acquired by Cisco Systems. He managed Cisco's Gigabit Systems
 Business Unit responsible for the highest-volume modular switching
 platform in the industry.
- Bechtolsheim's technology foresight is legendary. He was an earlystage investor in Google, VMware, Mellanox, Brocade and Magma Design, among many others. Today he is co-founder and chairman of Arista Networks, a high-speed datacenter and cloud networking company.
